Pre-CanSkate (3 to 5 year olds) / CanSkate (Stages 1 to 6)

Pre-CanSkate: 45-minute lessons for young beginner skaters with little experience. Activities are age appropriate with more emphasis on individual attention. We recommend that skaters be able to stand up and balance on skates on the ice.

CanSkate: 45-minute lessons skating lessons in the #1 Learn to Skate Program in Canada. Emphasis on fun and continuous movement. Skaters progress at their own speed through this Skate Canada sanctioned program. Awards and incentives are used to motivate skaters to achieve their personal best.

The Skate Canada member fee \$43.65 is payable once per year, for the period September 1, 2019 to August 31, 2020

Skating more than one session per week is **highly recommended**, as skaters will have more ice time to practice and will progress faster.

2 sessions per week: 5% off

3 sessions per week: 10% off

4 sessions per week: 15% off

No skate rentals available. Skaters must bring their own skates and a CSA approved hockey helmet.

Gloves and waterproof pants are recommended.

Reminder: Parents please do not leave the ice rink during your skater's lesson.
